

A2 The future of medicine

Instruction: Follow these general guidelines. Use the links provided on the syllabus website. Underlined items are links to ADDITIONAL support.

[Aims](#)

Stage 1

- Ask students when people go to the doctor's.
- Click on the **Stage 1** link. Play the video with SOUND OFF. Play the video till 0.50 and pause it. Students try to guess what the patient and the doctor are saying.
- Play the video till 1.27 and ask students to compare their notes with the video.
- Play the video from 1.27 and follow the instructions till 2.44

Stage 2

- Click on the **Stage 2** link. Ask students to find the website on their tablets. Divide the students into two groups: A – doctors B- patients. Give them some time to explore the website.
- Group A – doctors – look at phrases that could be useful and think of advice that you could give to the patient (stronger students)
- Group B- patients – look at phrases that could be useful and symptoms you might have (weaker students)
- Pair students and give them 1 or 2 minutes to role-play the conversations

HOMEWORK

- Students interview their host families: *Have you ever been a patient in a hospital? Do you like doctors? Have you ever had an accident? Have you ever talked to an online doctor?*
